



A LETTER FROM OUR FOUNDER

2022 was without a doubt a phenomenal year with huge victories both on and off the racetrack. On-track, my No. 22 Team Penske crew started off the year by celebrating a win at the inaugural NASCAR CLASH inside the LA Coliseum - the first race behind the wheel of the Next Gen car. Later that season, we as a team were able to celebrate in Victory Lane at Darlington, Gateway, Vegas, and win the final race of the season at Phoenix Raceway, which ultimately secured my second career NASCAR Cup Series Championship. Off-track, the Joey Logano Foundation (JLF) had just as much to celebrate about as we were able to collectively donate \$346,332 through grants to six organizations who support the foster care community. Brittany and I also pledged and matched all donations to JLF in 2022 up to \$222,000, which helped fund additional charitable events throughout the year. In addition to funding, JLF hosted four new members of the JL Kids Crew program, one of our favorite initiatives providing a once-in-a-lifetime race day experience. Midyear, JLF and the No. 22 Team assembled 1,000 backpacks full of essential supplies which were distributed to five foster care organizations throughout the Carolinas. In partnership with Ford Performance, the year finished on a high note as JLF helped sponsor and participate in a special

Christmas Party for Children's Hope Alliance foster families in Statesville, NC.

As you go through this report, you will see photos and read stories that speak to and honor the impact created by your support for our country's most vulnerable children. Together we are empowering future generations and thank you for your generosity.



CRITICAL ASSISTANCE RELIEF EFFORT

A JOEY LOGANO FOUNDATION PROGRAM THAT ORIGINATED TO SUPPLY ESSENTIAL ITEMS TO CHILDREN ENTERING FOSTER CARE ALSO SPREAD IT'S REACH AT THE ONSET OF COVID-19 TO PROVIDE SUPPORT FOR FAMILIES IN CRISIS AND FRONTLINE WORKERS.
